November 5, 2011

AM Session - Basic Engineering Economics

This session of Basic Engineering Economics provides the fundamental principles and elements that are vital for determining the feasibility and economic impact of the project.

PM Session - Advanced Engineering Economics

This session further defines the fundamental methods and concepts as discussed in the Basic Engineering Economics session. The advanced session provides the individual with an increased knowledge of the more in-depth methods and various techniques of determining the financial impacts and feasibility for their respective corporations.

November 12, 2011

AM Session - Estimating Basics

This session of Basic Estimating provides the fundamental principles and elements that are vital to the estimating process. This session will also provide an understanding of specialty estimating techniques for buildings, facilities, process industry and other estimating applications.

PM Session - Advanced Estimating

This session retains the fundamental concepts as discussed in the Basic Estimating sessions while adding understanding to more in depth methods and various techniques of preparing cost estimates.

November 19, 2011

AM Session - Basic Planning

This session of Basic Planning provides the fundamental principles and elements that are required for developing the project plan, which includes WBS development, Procurement and Resource Planning.

PM Session - Advanced Planning & Scheduling

This session further defines the fundamental methods and concepts as discussed in the Basic Planning session. The advanced session provides the individual with an increased knowledge of the more in-depth methods and various techniques of developing, implementing and monitoring the project schedule. This session will also assist in introducing what-if scenarios and recovery planning.

November 26, 2011

AM Session - Progress & Performance

This session will provide the individual with an understanding of Earned Value Management, Progress & Performance Management and its role in the stewardship of projects. Various applications and variations will be presented.

PM Session - Cost Control & Management

This session offers a variety of cost management, cost analysis, economic, accounting, optimization and cost/design information applicable to almost any sector of industry and management.

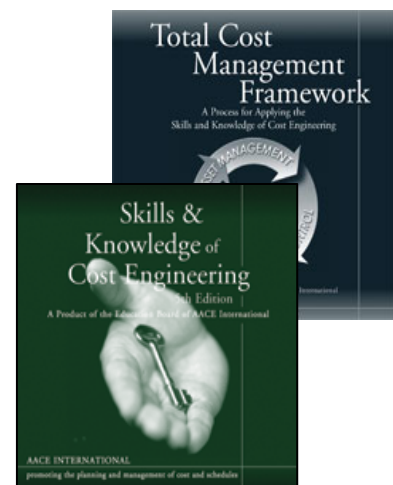

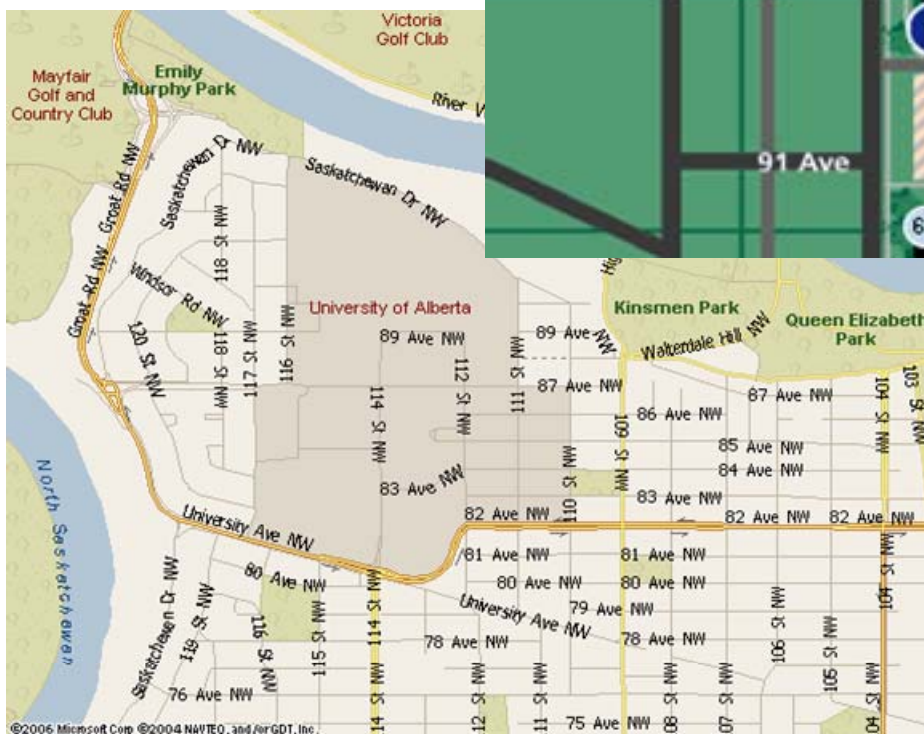
