**Abstract**

**Is Alberta in the position to capitalize on rapidly changing global forces?**

Paul Tsounis, Director of Energy Economics with the Energy Information and Analysis Branch of Alberta Energy, will provide insights on the fundamental shifts that have occurred in North American energy markets and how these shifts are impacting Alberta. Paul will provide insights as to Alberta's resource potential and its ability to penetrate its current (and future) markets for its crude oil, natural gas and value added resources. This discussion will also include insights into current price trends, pipeline issues, refineries and international energy market trends.

**Presenter: Paul Tsounis (M.A. Economics and Finance)**

Paul Tsounis is currently the Director of Resource Economics in the Energy Information and Analysis Branch in Alberta Energy. In the 8 years that Paul has been a part of the Branch, he has led a group of professionals responsible for monitoring global and North American energy market conditions and trends, energy price forecasting, royalty policy analysis and is now conducting upstream resource economics analysis, including the royalty review and climate change.

Prior to his current position in Alberta Energy, Paul also was Chief Economist with the City of Edmonton for 5 years, Senior Economist with Alberta Treasury Board and Finance for 3 years, and an Economist with the Oil Sands Business Unit at Alberta Energy for one year.

Paul holds a Master's Degree in Economics and Finance from the University of Alberta, and an undergraduate degree in Economics from the University of Calgary.
